

DESIGN FOR BUTTONS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 8,906, dated January 18, 1876; application filed December 22, 1875. [Term of Patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Beit known that I, ISAAC LEHMANN, of the city, county, and State of New York, have originated and designed a new and ornamental Pattern or Design for Buttons, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

A represents the body of the button, which is of dome shape on its face, and is surrounded by a fillet, B, at its base or back. The

dome-shaped face of the body A is ornamented by a figure representing a woven material, consisting of ropes a and bands b, interlacing one another at right angles, and giving to said surface a fancy check-like appearance.
What I claim as my invention is—

A design for a button, in which the face of the body is of dome shape, and ornamented with representations of ropes and bands, interlacing each other at right angles, and surrounded by a fillet, substantially as specified.
